

Attending services on Sunday

Sunday will be a little different as we have to be covid secure to be able to open. Before arriving, please make sure you have let us know you are coming. At present there will be a booking system, so please don't just arrive on Sunday morning. This will help us to ensure we have the right seating in place for those attending.

The service will have communion. You must bring your own bread and communion wine (or alternative, this must be non alcoholic). Bread and wine will NOT be provided.

Please read the Powerpoint/PDF document sent with this email. This gives you all the information you need for arriving and leaving the church building.

Key principles

There is now a one way system through out the church building.

There can be no shared resources, no news sheets, bibles, hymn books, toys for children, communion plates, collection.

There will be no collection, those wishing to give should contact the church office and advice can be given for alternative methods of giving.

There can be no singing or dancing.

Please do not turn to talk to those around you while you wait for the service to start or end.

There can be no chatting when walking into the sanctuary as respiratory droplets could land on those people seated.

Please remain seated throughout the service. Children will also need to remain seated and there will not be promises groups running at present. The family room is closed.

While we have a toilet open, we would ask you to avoid using this if at all possible. If you do use the toilet, please use the cleaning station provided.

We will need to keep a record of all those attending for 21days. If there was a case of Covid19 within the church, this information would need to be shared with the NHS Track and Trace service. When you arrive the service supervisor will check your contact details with you to ensure these are up to date.

Hands must be sanitised on entry and exit.

The Baptist union has advised that all those attending wearing face coverings while in the building. Members will be notified of this prior to attending, but this will not be mandatory.

Please take all our belongings away with and that includes what is left over from Communion.
